Gog – Magog War Participants

Magog

- Grandson of Noah, son of Japhet, brother of Gomer, Tubal, and Meshech (Genesis 10)
- Called Scythians by the Greeks (1)
- Called Scythians by the "ancients"- roamed around and north of the Black and Caspian Seas (2)
- North and East Armenia (3)

Meshech

- Grandson of Noah, son of Japhet, brother of Gomer, Tubal, and Magog (Genesis 10)
- The Mosocheni were founded by Mosoch; now they are Cappadocians. (1)
- Cappadocia and Meshech: areas of north/central, north/east Turkey. (4)
- Under the control of The Prince of Rosh; is "reproduced" in the modern town of Moscow. (2)

Tubal

- Grandson of Noah, son of Japhet, brother of Gomer, Meshech, and Magog. (Genesis 10)
- Under the control of The Prince of Rosh and is "reproduced" in the modern city of Tobolsk. (2)
- Central Asia Minor, area of Cappadocia (5)

Rosh

- A southeastern Slavic tribe, coming out of northern Armenia that eventually became Russia (6)
- "Careful research has established the fact that the progenitor of Rosh was Tiraz (Gen. x:2) and that Rosh is Russia." (2)

Gomer

- Grandson of Noah, son of Japhet, brother of Magog, Meshech, and Tubal. (Genesis 10)
- founded those who the Greeks called Galatians. (1)
- Descendants moved north into central Europe to Germany and into the Danube and the Rhine valley areas. (5), (6)

Togarmah

- Son of Gomer. (Genesis 10)
- Central and east/central Turkey. Armenia area (7), (8)

Ethiopia

- Cush, south of Egypt, includes all of "black" Africa (6)
- Final Destruction along with Egypt and Libya (9)

Phut

- Associated with North Africa: Algeria, Tunisia, and Morocco. (6)
- The founder of Libya (1)
- Final Destruction along with Egypt and Ethiopia in Jeremiah (9)
