Prophetic Fate of Islamic Nations

EGYPT

(Ezekiel 29) thou shalt fall upon the open fields--I have given thee--to the beasts of the field and to the fowls of the heaven--I will bring a sword upon thee--the land of Egypt shall be desolate and waste--I will make the land of Egypt utterly waste and desolate, from the tower of Syene even unto the border of Ethiopia--No foot of man shall pass through it, nor foot of beast shall pass through it, neither shall it be inhabited forty years--I will make the land of Egypt desolate in the midst of the countries that are desolate, and her cities among the cities that are laid waste shall be desolate forty years: and I will scatter the Egyptians among the nations, and will disperse them through the countries--Yet thus saith the Lord GOD; At the end of forty years will I gather the Egyptians from the people whither they were scattered--I will cause them to return into the land of Pathros, into the land of their habitation; and they shall be there a base kingdom.

(Daniel 11:40-45) at the time of the end shall the king of the south push at him: and the king of the north shall come against him like a whirlwind--and he shall enter into the countries, and shall overflow and pass over--He shall enter also into the glorious land, and many countries shall be overthrown: but these shall escape out of his hand, even Edom, and Moab, and the chief of the children of Ammon--He shall stretch forth his hand also upon the countries: and the land of Egypt shall not escape {43} But he shall have power over the treasures of gold and of silver, and over all the precious things of Egypt: and the Libyans and the Ethiopians shall be at his steps. {44} But tidings out of the east and out of the north shall trouble him: therefore he shall go forth with great fury to destroy, and utterly to make away many. {45} And he shall plant the tabernacles of his palace between the seas in the glorious holy mountain; yet he shall come to his end, and none shall help him.

PHILISTINES – GAZA STRIP – LEBANON – PHOENICIANS

(Jeremiah 47) The word against the Philistines--Behold, waters rise up out of the north, and shall be an overflowing flood, and shall overflow the land, and all that is therein; the city, and them that dwell therein--for the LORD will spoil the Philistines--O thou sword of the LORD, how long will it be ere thou be quiet? put up thyself into thy scabbard, rest, and be still. {7} How can it be quiet, seeing the LORD hath given it a charge against Ashkelon, and against the sea shore? there hath he appointed it.

(Ezekiel 25:15-16) Because the Philistines have dealt by revenge--have taken vengeance with a despiteful heart, to destroy it for the old hatred--I will destroy the remnant of the sea coast.

(Jeremiah 49:36) And upon Elam will I bring the four winds from the four quarters of heaven, and will scatter them toward all those winds; and there shall be no nation whither the outcasts of Elam shall not come.

(Nahum 1:5-8) [Nineveh] The mountains quake at him--the hills melt--the earth is burned at his presence--the world all that dwell therein--his fury is poured out like fire, and the rocks are thrown down by him--But with an overrunning flood he will make an utter end of the place thereof

BABYLON

Thus far are the words of Jeremiah

(Jeremiah 51:7) Babylon hath been a golden cup in the LORD'S hand, that made all the earth drunken: the nations have drunken of her wine; therefore the nations are mad.

(Isaiah 10:26) And the LORD of hosts shall stir up a scourge for him according to the slaughter of Midian at the rock of Oreb: and as his rod was upon the sea, so shall he lift it up after the manner of Egypt. JUDGES 7.25

(Jeremiah 50:23) How is the hammer of the whole earth cut asunder and broken! how is Babylon become a desolation among the nations!

(Jeremiah 50:25) The LORD hath opened his armoury, and hath brought forth the weapons of his indignation
